

IMC ALUMNI AWARD

The goal

The aim of the IMC Alumni Award is to honour alumni of the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems for special achievements in the categories mentioned below, to bring them before the curtain and to show them the high status they have as stakeholders for their former university.

The criteria and categories at a glance

Must criterion:

A candidate must have been a graduate of IMC FH Krems for at least five years. Graduates are all those who have an academic degree (Mag. (FH), DI (FH) BA, BSc or MA/MSc) from IMC FH Krems (regardless of location).

Categories

Starting in the academic year 2019/20, the IMC Alumni Awards will be awarded in the following five categories. A maximum of 2 awards per year will be presented per category. The management team of the IMC FH Krems reserves the right to decide whether no or only one award will be presented in a category.

First category: Entrepreneurship/start-up/innovative business idea

Particular success in company formation/acquisition, successful innovative business ideas or start-ups, particularly successful freelance activities

Second category: Professional career (employed)

Very successful and exceptional professional career, national or international.

Third category: Scientific career/awards for scientific work and research

Successful academic career at home or abroad and/or national and/or international awards for special professional, social or academic achievements such as prizes, decorations, special publications.

Category 4: Sports/Art/Culture/Corporate Social Responsibility

Exceptional athletic performance in top-class sport, cultural or artistic achievements after completion of studies - special, above-average social or charitable commitment - professionally or privately. Special achievements/contributions/activities in the field of CSR.

Category 5: Commitment to IMC FH Krems

Sustainable commitment towards the IMC FH Krems as for example: IMC Alumni Ambassador, mentor within the framework of the mentoring programme, guest or part-time lecturer, specialist lecturer, internship partner, sponsor, sustainable approaching of job offers, as well as further honorary activities for the IMC FH Krems.



The Mode - The Nomination

The nomination can be made:

- By a graduate recommended by another graduate
- by the graduate himself/herself (self-nomination) or
- by the IMC FH Krems (management team, heads of institutes, heads of degree programmes)

1. Nomination via an alumna/us or self-nomination

You can nominate yourself or another graduate. You send a letter of application to Alumni Relations by the end of January with reference to the criteria of the individual categories and your CV. A Xing or LinkedIn profile can be provided. The application deadline/nomination ends on 31 January. The information will be sent to the submitter or nominees by the end of June.

2. The nomination by IMC FH Krems

The nomination is also made in writing by the management team or the heads of the study programmes and institutes, stating the reasons and referring to the criteria.

Selection of nominees

The selection will be made by the end of June at the latest by the management team of the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems. The CV (in detail) and the assessment by the management team serve as a basis. After the selection, the nominees will be notified and invited to a festive award ceremony within the framework of the ceremony "Awarding of Functional and Honorary Titles".

Subsequently, the IMC Alumni Awardees will be networked within the framework of an Alumni Awardees Dinner and will be asked for an honorary commitment to the IMC FH Krems (Career Center, Mentoring, Programme Development, etc.).
