

Supplementary Examinations for admission to Bachelor degree programmes - Information Sheet

1. General Information

According to § 4 (6) University of Applied Sciences Act (FHG) candidates seeking admission to an Austrian Bachelor degree programme have to bring proof of a secondary school leaving certificate equivalent to contents and requirements of an Austrian secondary school leaving examination; The programme director shall prescribe supplementary examinations that are necessary to establish an equivalence with the domestic secondary school leaving examination and which shall be passed prior to admission.

Depending on the chosen Bachelor degree programme, the supplementary exams may vary in number and subject area. The conditional admission letter provides specific information about the supplementary exams which apply to you.

All exams have to be passed in order to be finally admitted to the Bachelor degree programme. In case of one negative result, repetition of this one exam is possible. In case of a repeated failure or more than one negative result in the exams, admission to the Bachelor degree programme is not granted.

2. Online Prep Summer School for English and Mathematics

The Prep Summer School gives you the opportunity to study by yourself via online courses. A lecturer guided Q&A session will be offered before the exam to clarify possible questions and to achieve the best possible results.

The online Prep Summer School commences in the course of June 2022 with self-study online preparation. You will be invited to the online courses via email, please make sure that you have access to your emails on a regular basis.

For all other subjects, please purchase the books named below. The details concerning preparation and exam will be provided as soon as possible.

3. Costs

The fee for Prep Summer School and one examination attempt is **EUR 650,-**, regardless of the numbers of subjects.

The access to the online prep course is granted to you in the course of June. If payment is not received until the 15th of July 2022, you are suspended from the Prep Summer School and admission to the Bachelor degree programme will not be granted.
